- A feathered date bar denotes uncertainty. It does not mean the event happened over a period of years.
- A solid date bar indicates the year that the event happened. It does mean it lasted a year. Few dates are known to within a few months. If the month is known, the text says so.
- A solid date bar that spans multiple years means the event lasted that many years.
- A "?" indicates that the event is likely but not certain, or the place is uncertain.
- The width of the text box has no bearing on the date except to align with the left edge of the date bar.
- Events in gray are extrabiblical. The sources are reliable but there are no Scripture reference for them.
